American Solar Electric Donates PV Systems to Habitat for Humanity

Solar Power to Help Offset Utility Bills for Two Glendale Families

(Scottsdale, AZ) – Paying the power bill will be a little easier for two families in Glendale, Arizona when they move into their new homes in the coming months. Scottsdale-based American Solar Electric has committed to donate equipment and installation services for two grid-tied photovoltaic power systems to Valley of the Sun Habitat for Humanity.

The systems will be installed on homes currently being built by volunteer groups near the heart of Glendale, Arizona. Electricity generated by the solar electric systems will be used to offset utility power, thereby reducing the cost of electricity for the new homeowners.

"We appreciate the partnership of American Solar Electric and are excited about the opportunity to help these two Habitat families create stability in a safe, decent environment. Alternative forms of energy help our families as well as the greater community," said Missie D'Aunoy, Chief Development Officer of Habitat for Humanity Valley of the Sun.
